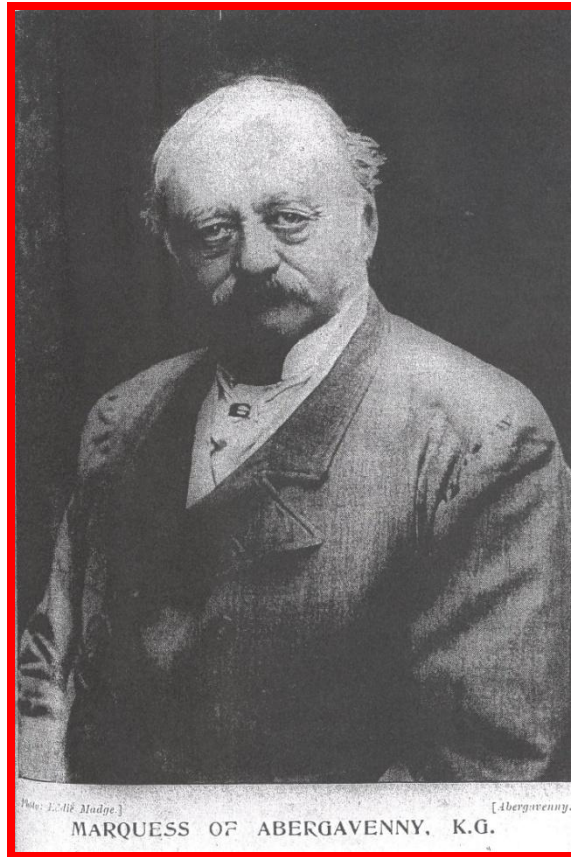

William Nevill 5th Earl of Abergavenny Born 16 Sept 1826 Died 12 December 1915. Became 1st Marquess of Abergavenny in 1876

Abergavenny v Penarth in 1905 was a match that was played as a benefit for the Abergavenny professional of that year, Perrin. Abergavenny 78 all out, WP Lewis (12) JR Jacob (21) and W.Llewellyn (11) Penarth 183 with 3 wickets for FS Perkins and J.Jonathan. Abergavennys full team that day- SW White, WP Lewis, JR Jacob, Perrin, M.Harris, J.Jonathan, W.Llewellyn, M.Evans, FS Perkins, JC Jenkins and EW Richards.

TREVETHIN v. ABERGAVENNY 2NDs.	
The above match was played at Abergavenny on Thursday, May 4th. Abergavenny had the assistance of several of their first eleven, and winning the toss, elected to bat first, sending in J. R. Jacob and M. Evans to the trundling of T. Flowers and J. P. Jones . Runs came steadily, 30 being put on before J. R. Jacob was bowled by a good ball from W. Pugh , who had taken the place of J. P. Jones . Wickets began to fall quickly after this. Only G. Ambrose played with any confidence—he was well caught by J. Flood at square leg. Eventually the innings closed for the total of 44 runs. Trevethin started their innings to the bowling of F. H. Perkins and G. Ambrose , who, by the by, if playing under his right name, would be recognised as a prominent county bowler. All the Trevethin batsmen succeeded in making runs, and when the last man was bowled the respectable total of 62 had been notched, leaving Trevethin winners by 18 runs. W. Pugh and T. Flowers batted well, making 13 each. G. Ambrose , for Abergavenny, bowled splendidly, taking five wickets at a very small cost. Scores:—
