

Abergavenny 77 H.Sharpe (25) Glamorgan CCC 186-8 Guy O'Daly 5-62, on the strength of this display G.O'Daly was picked to play for Glamorgan against Cambridge University at Swansea a few days later, when after bowling 7 overs for 17 runs he dislocated his knee and remained out of action until August Week. Glamorgan Colts also visited the Club and played out a draw. The end of season batting and bowling awards were won by the following- 1st X1 Batting- GN O'Daly, Bowling WH Robinson. 2nd X1 Batting award-W.Adams, Bowling award- J.Kendall. Thursday X1 Batting Award and Bowling awards were won by HL Kendall but as no single player is allowed to win more than one bat the bowling award was presented to AL Pragnall.
