The 1<sup>st</sup> X1 played seventeen (17) winning eight(8) Losing three (3) and Drawing six (6) The 2<sup>nd</sup> x1 played a total of twelve fixtures winning five (5) losing six (6) and drawing just one (1), whilst the Thursday X1 played fourteen (14) Winning seven (7) Losing three (3) and drawing four (4)

Glamorgan Colts drew with the Club in July 27<sup>th</sup> but were beaten by Abergavenny during the August Cricket Week.

The August Week fixtures were planned as follows- Monday- Crickhowell, Tuesday- Nailsworth, Thursday- Monmouthshire Police, Friday- Old Herefordonians. The breaking out of hostilities at the end of August brought the season to a sudden and inglorious end and the big Finals of such Sports Associations as the GPO and GWR due to be held on the ground were nit held. By now the Club was 6 years in arrears to the ground company for rent. With peace time cricket failing to pay its way there was grave doubts that war time cricket could do so. The Club stewardess was Mrs Morris and her assistant Mrs Dibbins.
