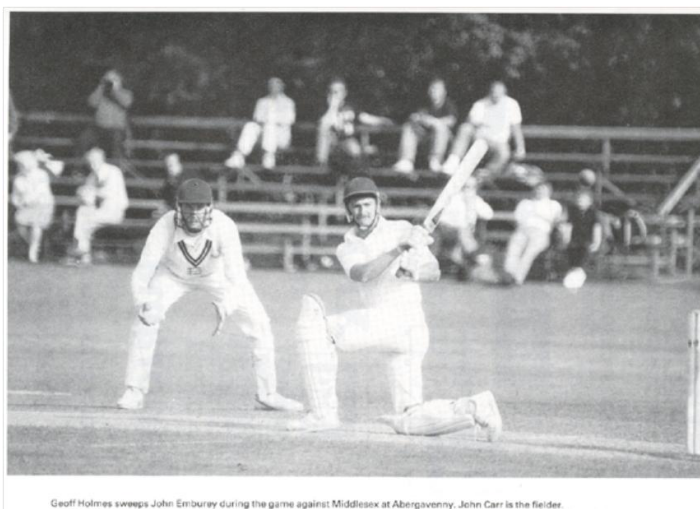


## 1989- County Championship game v Middlesex CCC

Geoff Holmes sweeps John Embury during the game against Middlesex at Abergavenny. John Carr is the fielder.

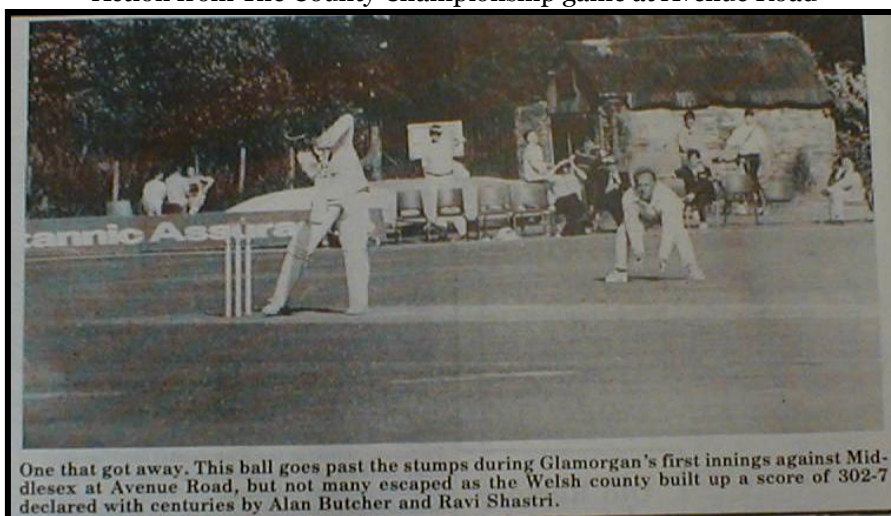


Alan Butcher on his way to a century against Middlesex at Abergavenny in June. Paul Downton, who also made a hundred in the game, is the wicket keeper.
