

1990- County Championship Game v Worcestershire CCC

1990 the returning County was Worcestershire for a 3 day County Championship match, it became a GA Hick repeat performance from 1988 only better as he amassed 252 Not Out in the First Innings supported by a century from DB D'Oliveira and 100 Not Out in the second innings this time supported by a century from Tim Curtis. Glamorgan had three centurions themselves, H.Morris,A.Cottey and A.Butcher. In all there were 1,641 runs scored for the loss of only 16 wickets. IT Botham was resigned to a bit part player as was to a certain extent Vivian Richards.






