

1992- back to 3 day County Championship Game v Somerset

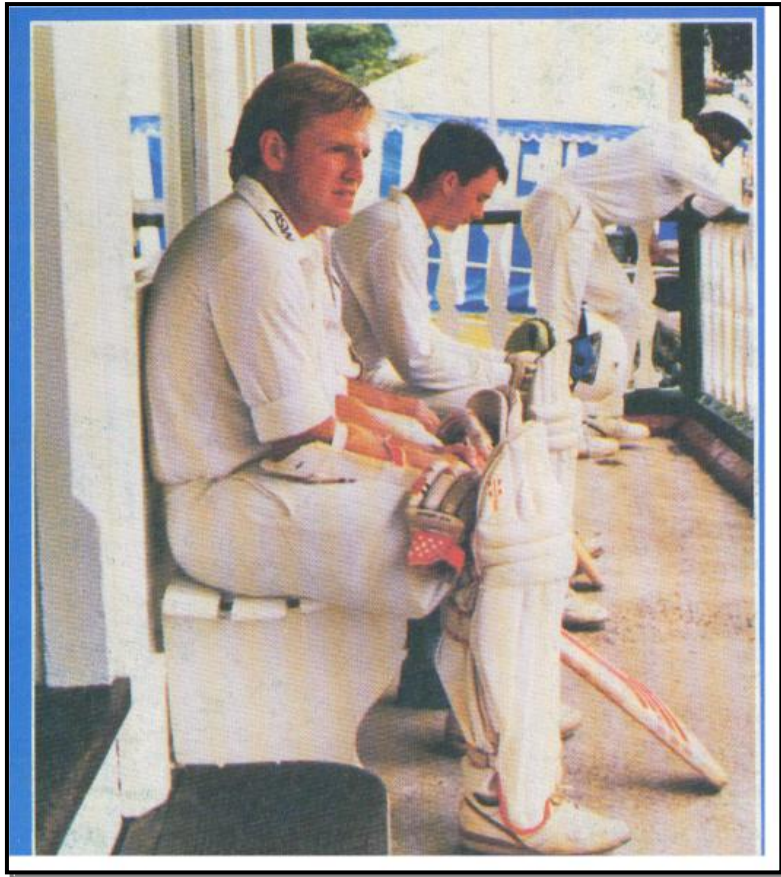

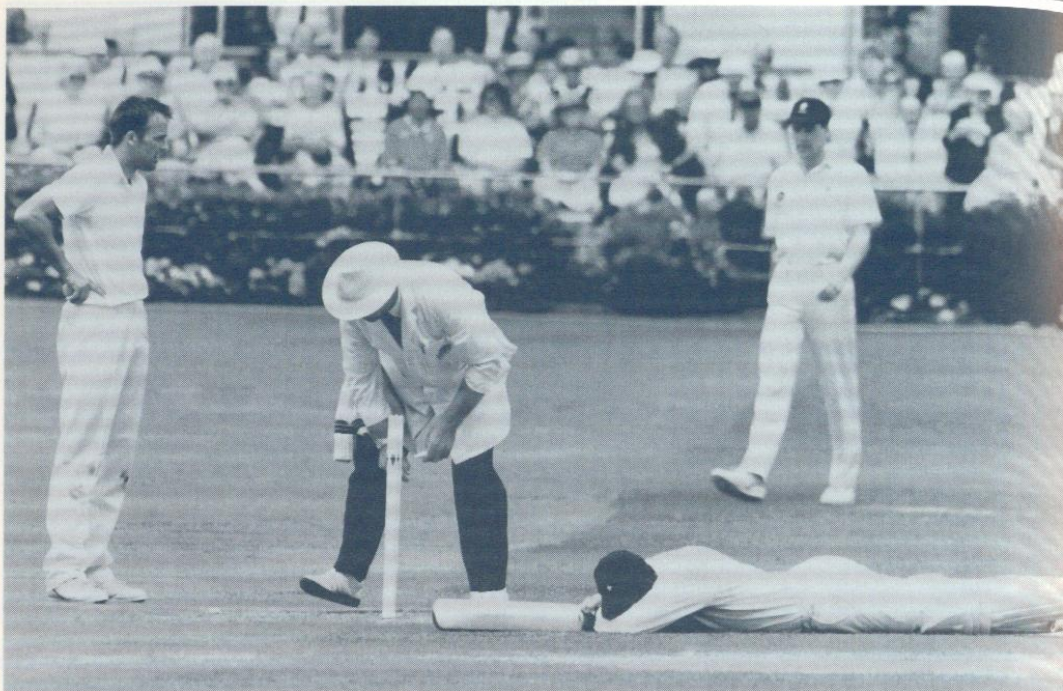

Ken Williams, Mac and what seems the entire complement of Abergavenny members, have ensured that the original pitch is dry and hard and the whole ground is as pretty as a picture postcard. The weather is good, the food brilliant and the breakfasts at 6-30 a.m. Make for a happy three days" For Glamorgan Abergavenny and Neath were the best placed grounds in the TCCB table of merit

MATCH DRAWN

Another entertaining match at Abergavenny ended in a draw after Somerset, set 335 to win in a minimum of 54 overs (though in the event 66.5 overs were bowled), held out for a draw. Glamorgan batted first and with Morris, who has a tremendous record on the ground, and Dale both making good scores, the total of 276 kept Glamorgan well in the game. Somerset declared 25 runs behind and Morris's fourth Championship century of the summer helped Maynard to set the target. Although Somerset lost regular wickets, Maynard kept the interest of the visitors alive by using the occasional bowling of Morris, but in the end the chase was abandoned. The match was highlighted by some tremendous catching, the efforts of Maynard and Richards in the first innings in particular.

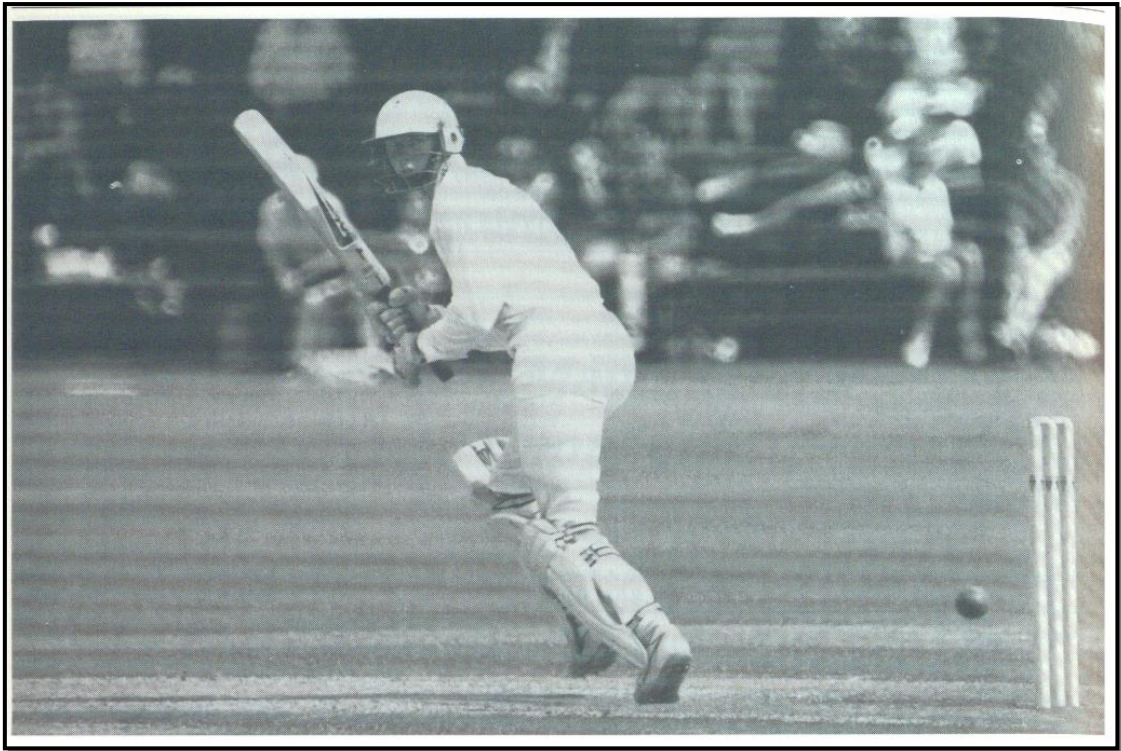
